Mel is said to have been the son of Conis and his wife, Darerca, the sister of Saint Patrick. Mel accompanied his uncle to Ireland and helped to evangelize in that country. Mel is said to have had no fixed diocese, which might be explained by his being a missionary. Saint Patrick himself built the church at Ardagh and to this he appointed his nephew, Mel. The cathedral at Ardagh is dedicated to Saint Mel. Acting upon the counsel of Saint Paul, Mel supported himself by working with his hands, and what he gained beyond bare necessities, he gave to the poor. The Feast of Saint Mel is on February 6th.

Our PSR program is held at St. Mark parish on Monday evenings from 6:30 - 7:30 in the school building. We serve students in Grades 1 - 8. Students in grades 2 and 8 are prepared to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist (grade 2) and Confirmation (Grade 8), as part of our curriculum. For a student to receive these Sacraments they MUST be enrolled and attend PSR the previous year.

FROM FR. ADAM

Friends,

The papal intention this past month was "for the formation of religious and seminarians, that religious women and men, and seminarians, grow in their own vocations through their human, pastoral, spiritual and community formation, leading them to be credible witnesses to the Gospel." It was a happy coincidence for us in particular to have this intention as we celebrated the ordination of Fr. Michael Garvin. The year of internship that we do as part of our formation program here in Cleveland is always very significant in the formation of our priestly vocations; for almost all seminarians, that is the first time that the idea of what it is to be a priest changes from an academic study to a practical experience. The memories that Fr. Michael has of his time with us is something that will always be important to him, and will shape how he lives out priesthood for many years to come.

For women and men entering religious life as well as seminarians preparing for priesthood, service to the Church is much more than a career and demands a high quality of person. We expect nuns and monks and priests to be holy people, to be people that know Christ and know how to live a life of sincere prayer and imitation of the entire gospel. The intention echoed what we call the four pillars of formation: human, pastoral, spiritual, and community. Those are the lenses through which formation programs focus their efforts on shaping someone as they discern these vocations. I know in my life without a moment's doubt, that my formation brought about dramatic growth; I simply would not be who I am without those years.

This month of June the papal intention will be, "for migrants fleeing their homes, that migrants fleeing from war or hunger, forced to undertake journeys full of danger and violence, find welcome and new opportunities in the countries that receive them."
