Once the potential nominees have confirmed their interest, we will ask them to submit their picture with a short introductory statement (just a few sentences about themselves) so that others in the parish can get to know them and "connect a name with a familiar face". This will most likely happen during the next few weeks. Pastoral Council elections will be during the month of May.

After the new members have been elected, we will likely have a joint Pastoral Council meeting this summer to say farewell to outgoing members and welcome the newly elected members.

The St. Mel Hall is available for rental. Catering options through St. Mel Hall are also available for your events, but it is also acceptable to rent the hall and utilize your own catering options.
