SAINT MEL

Mel is said to have been the son of Conis and his wife, Darerca, the sister of Saint Patrick. Mel accompanied his uncle to Ireland and helped to evangelize in that country. Mel is said to have had no fixed diocese, which might be explained by his being a missionary. Saint Patrick himself built the church at Ardagh and to this he appointed his nephew, Mel. The cathedral at Ardagh is dedicated to Saint Mel. Acting upon the counsel of Saint Paul, Mel supported himself by working with his hands, and what he gained beyond bare necessities, he gave to the poor. The Feast of Saint Mel is on February 6th.

PSR PROGRAM 2024 – 2025

A reminder that the PSR Program's first class will be Monday September 9th. You must be registered before the first class.

Our PSR program is held at St. Mark parish on Monday evenings from 6:30 - 7:30 in the school building. We serve students in Grades 1 - 8. Students in grades 2 and 8 are prepared to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist (grade 2) and Confirmation (Grade 8), as part of our curriculum. For a student to receive these Sacraments they MUST be enrolled and attend PSR the previous year.

Growing in FAITH

Discovering **hope** and **joy** in the Catholic faith

Friends,

On Friday, August 30 we will have a solemn exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 4:00pm. I hope you are able to come and spend an hour in prayer and adoration.

If you've never been to a solemn exposition before, it begins with exposing the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance and placing it on the altar. We read some scripture much like at a mass, but then we have an extended time for quiet prayer (probably about thirty minutes, with a hymn or two during it as well). In seminary I used to take that time to pray over things in my life in my mind, or sometimes I would read a bit of a spiritual book, or sometimes I would just rest a bit and enjoy the sacred peacefulness. At the end of the hour, I will incense the Blessed Sacrament and then give benediction, a unique blessing where I make the sign of the cross over all of you with the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance.

There's no special reason for the chosen date. The church's law recommends that every place which reserves the Blessed Sacrament in a tabernacle have a solemn exposition each year, so that the community may meditate on and adore the eucharistic mystery. The Diocese of Cleveland produces a schedule and asks different parishes to commit to different weeks throughout the year, and we were asked to do something in late August.
