- ▶ Deanery update: The Diocese has hired a moderator (lay person coordinator) for all of the deaneries (regional Diocesan groups), who will work in tandem with the appointed Dean (Father Rob Ramser from Our Lady of Angels Church) to manage the workings of the deaneries. The Diocese has, however, put the development of the deanery project on hold temporarily, due to unforeseen events. More information will come later when the Diocese announces more details.
- Window Project update: The Diocesan office is still working on details of the St. Mel school building window replacement project. The latest update from the Diocese is that the window project will likely occur next summer. Details are still being determined by the Diocese regarding the specific company that will be doing the window replacement work.
